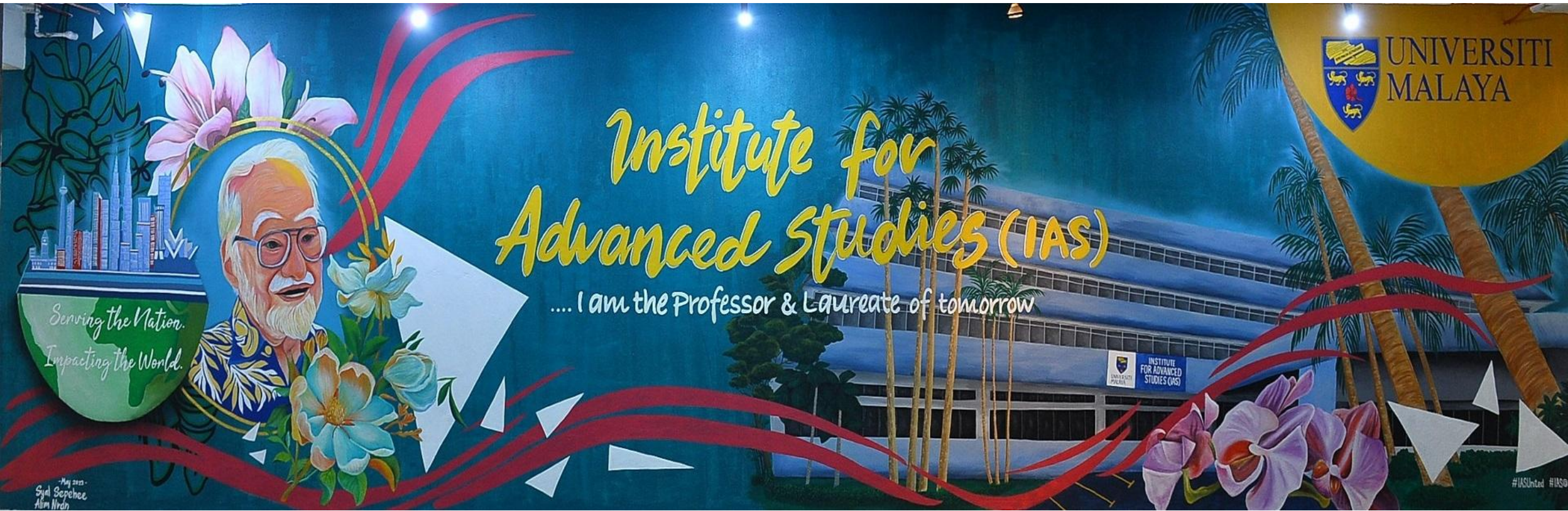

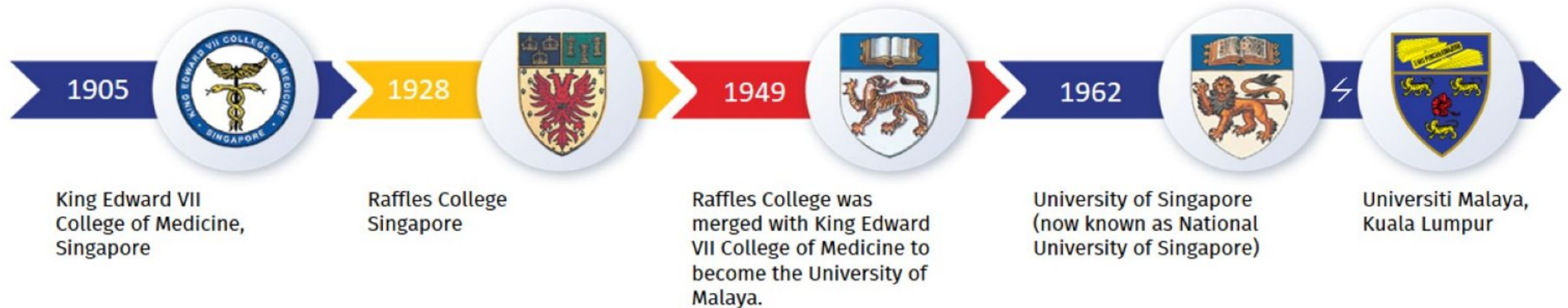

The King Edward VII College of Medicine was founded in 1905 to train the first Malaysian (Malayan) doctors. The College later became known as the University of Malaya in Singapore.

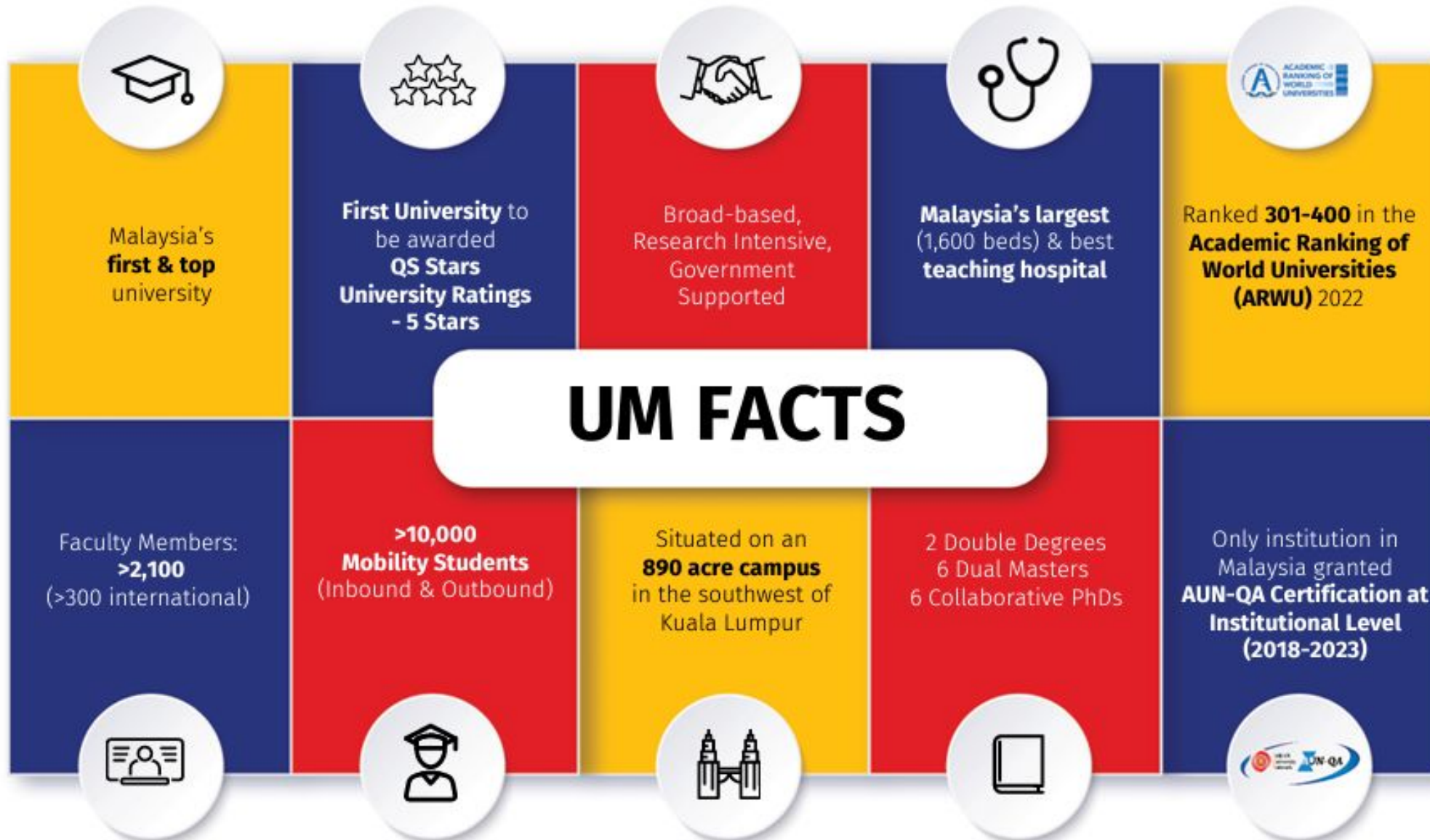


The Universiti Malaya, **Kuala Lumpur campus** was established in **1959**. The **University Hospital** was opened in **1968**.

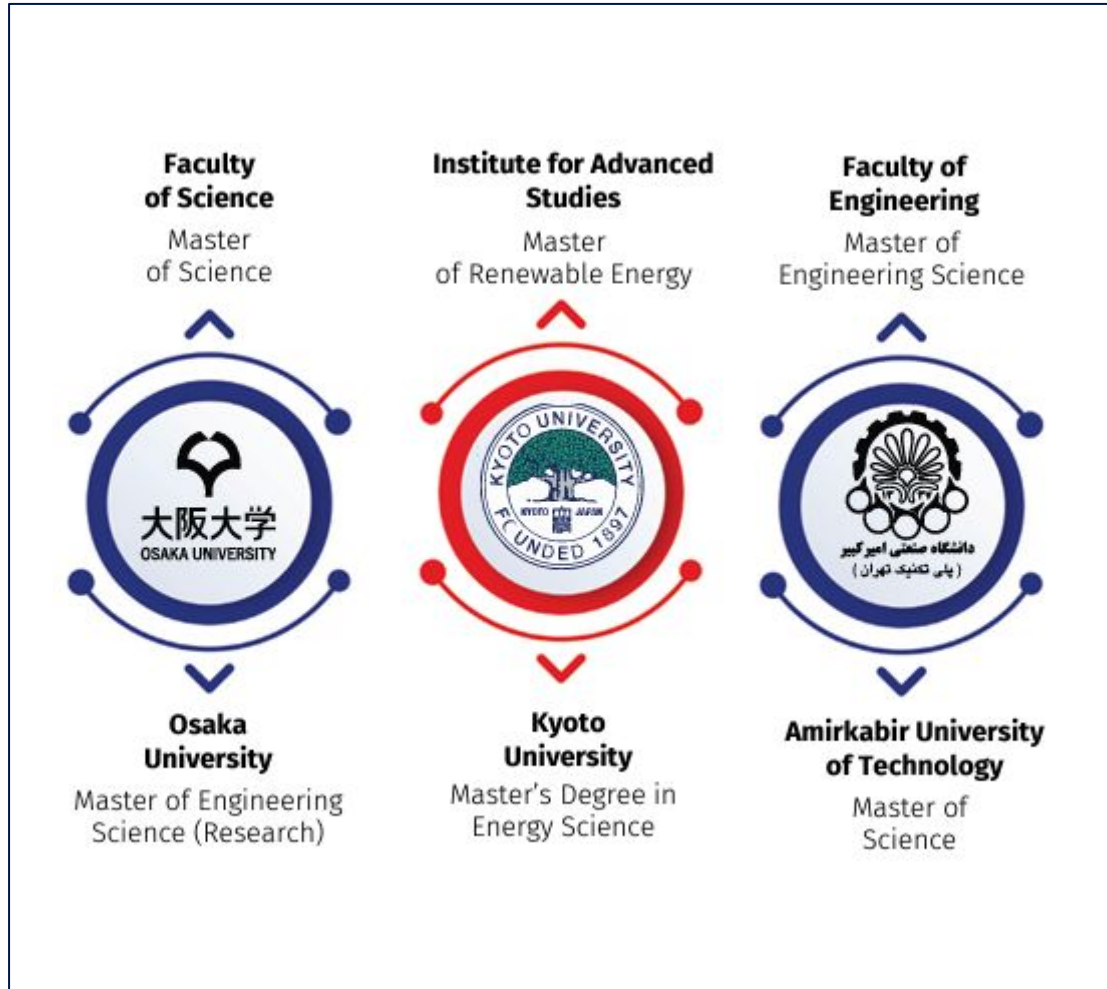

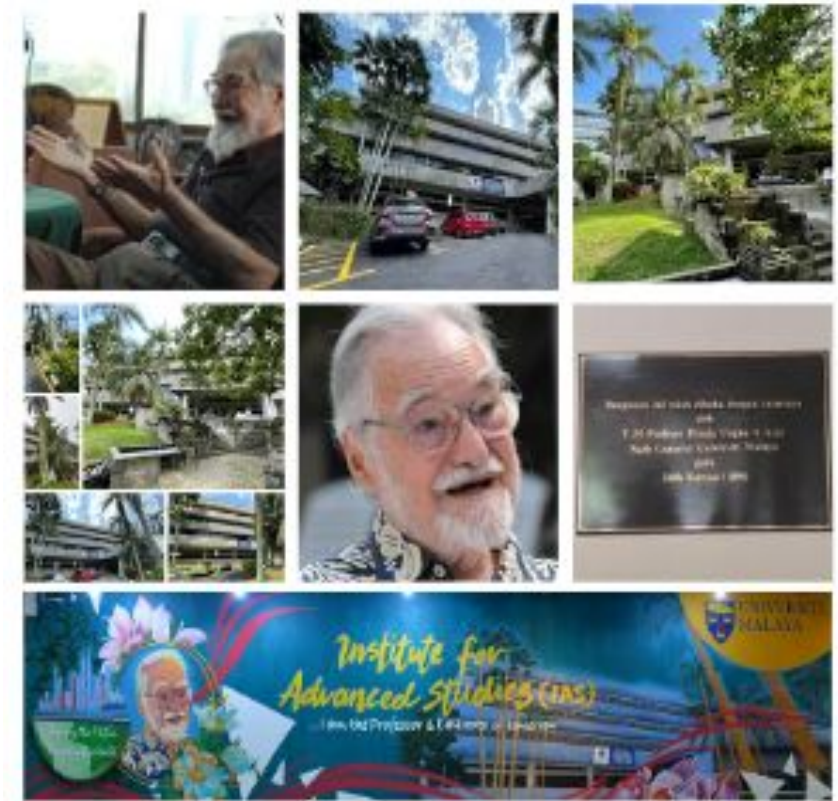

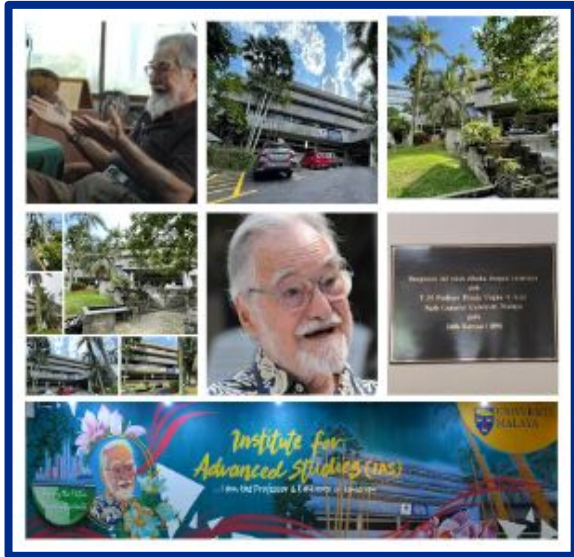


Our Purpose

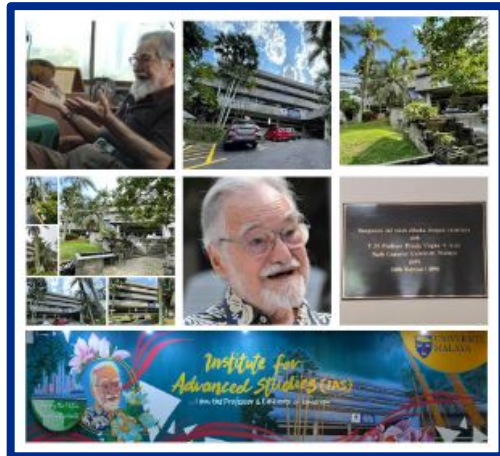
Institute for Advanced Studies (IAS) is the central platform for multidisciplinary academic and research programmes at Universiti Malaya.

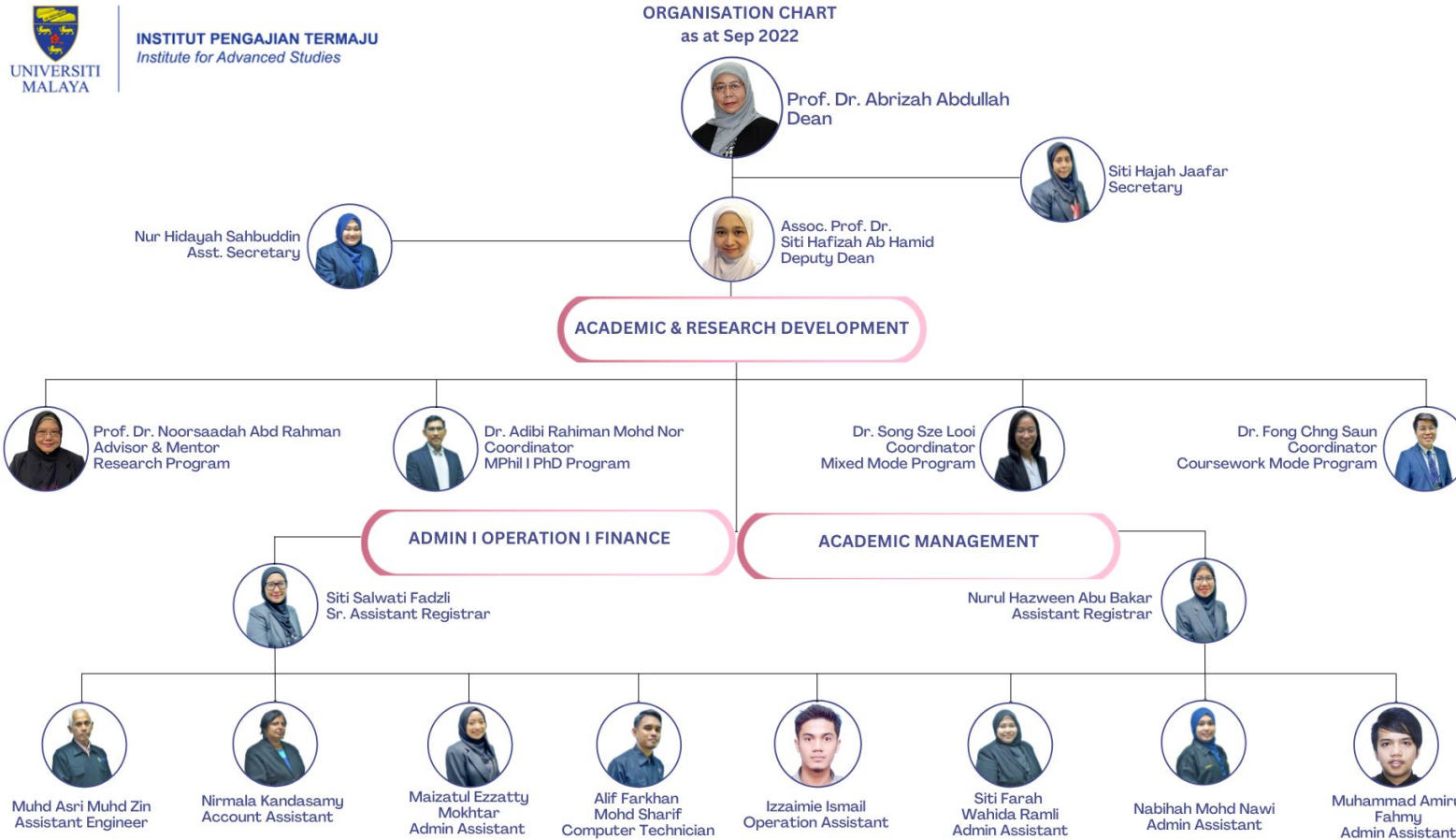

IAS Organisation Chart



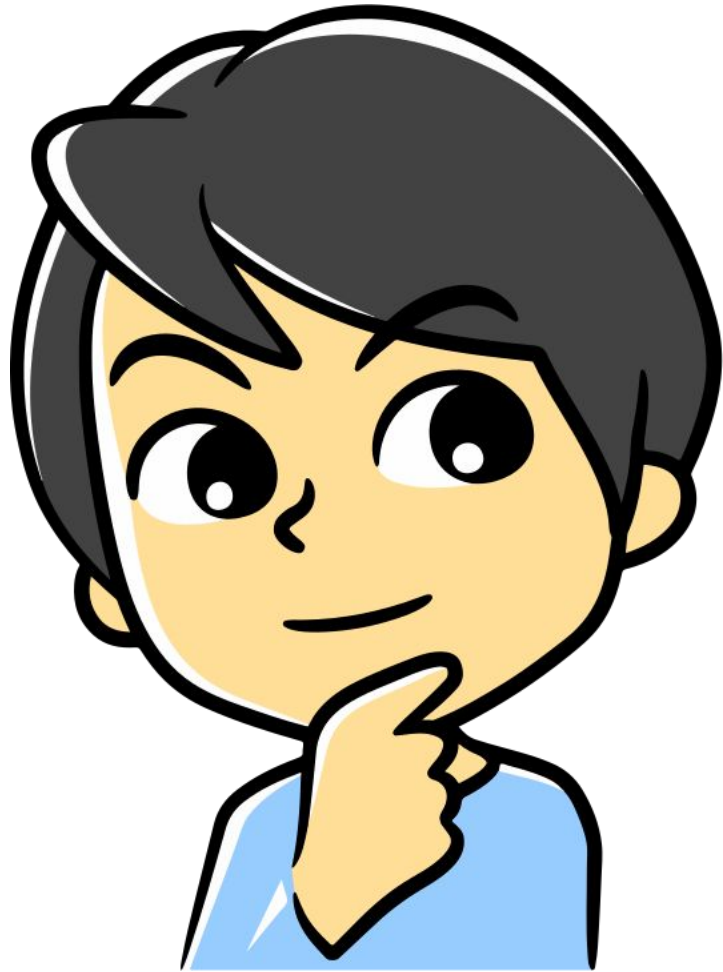

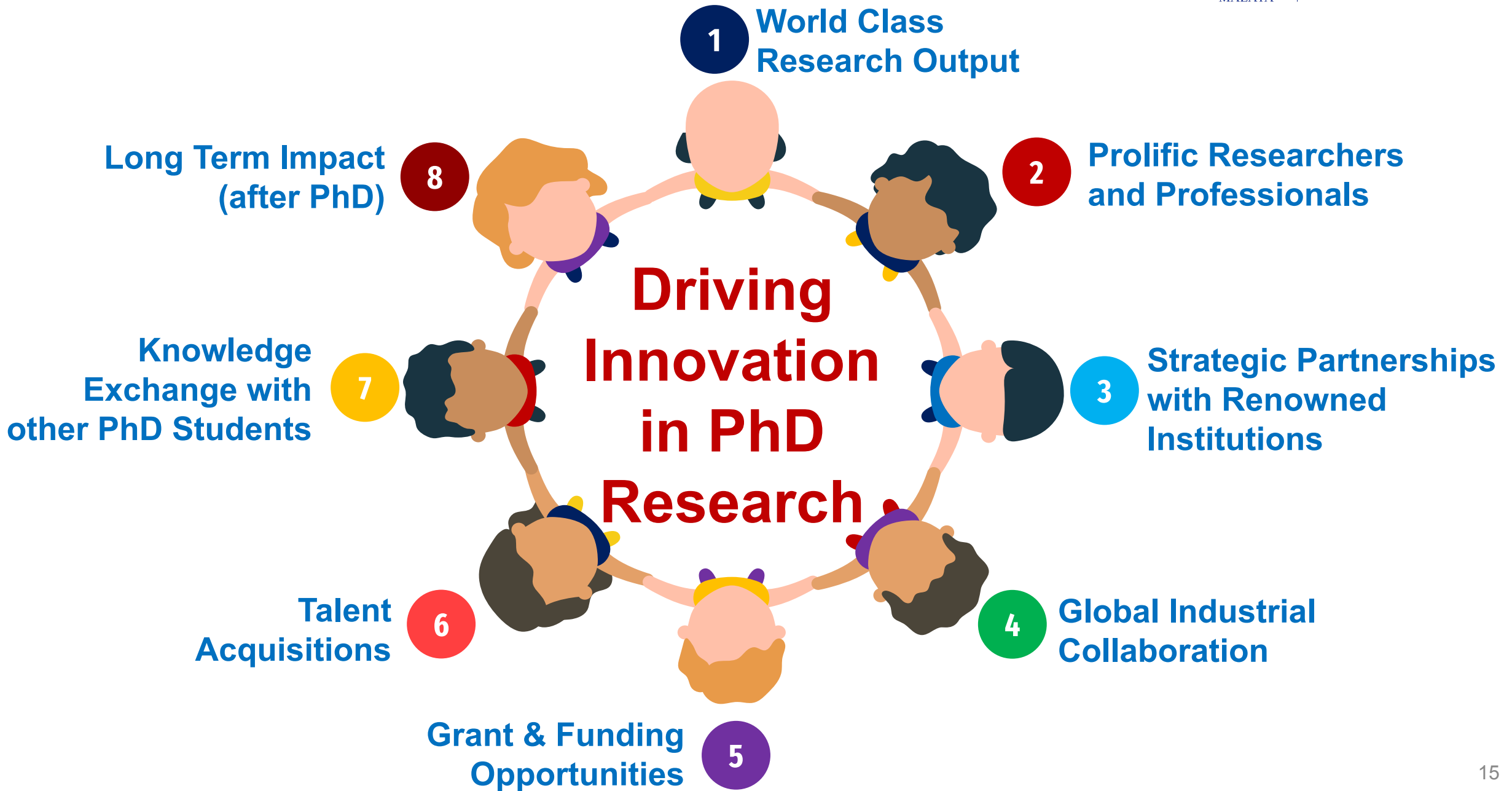

Definition of Multidisciplinary in IAS Academic/Research Programmes

[Presented in IAS Academic Advisory Committee No. 03/2022_20 April 2022]

01

Multidisciplinary (cross-disciplinary) research is required when a field of study, a topic or a problem of **research crosses the borders of disciplines (and faculties)**, as traditionally subjects indicate independent bodies of knowledge.

It is also a research approach in which the tools of **different sciences** (i.e. systematic organization of knowledge) and disciplines are utilised to explain the issue under study, as a means to **bridge gaps in problem-solving** that result from disciplinary specialisation.

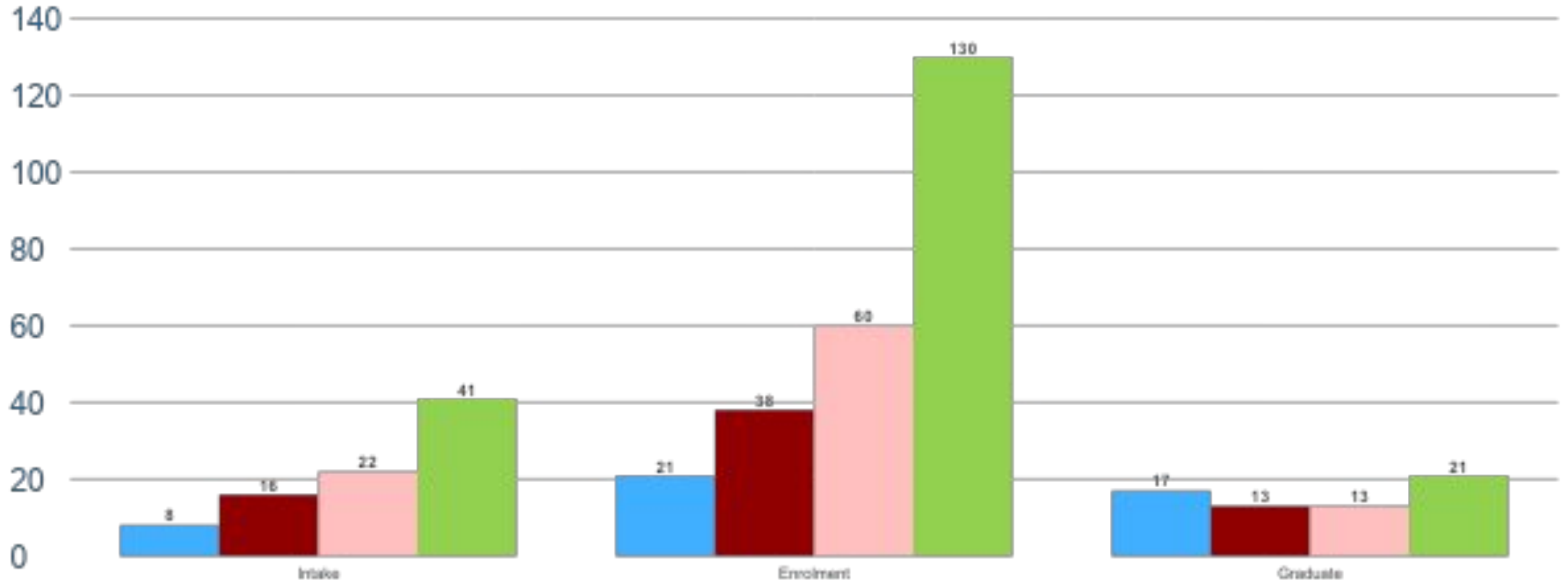

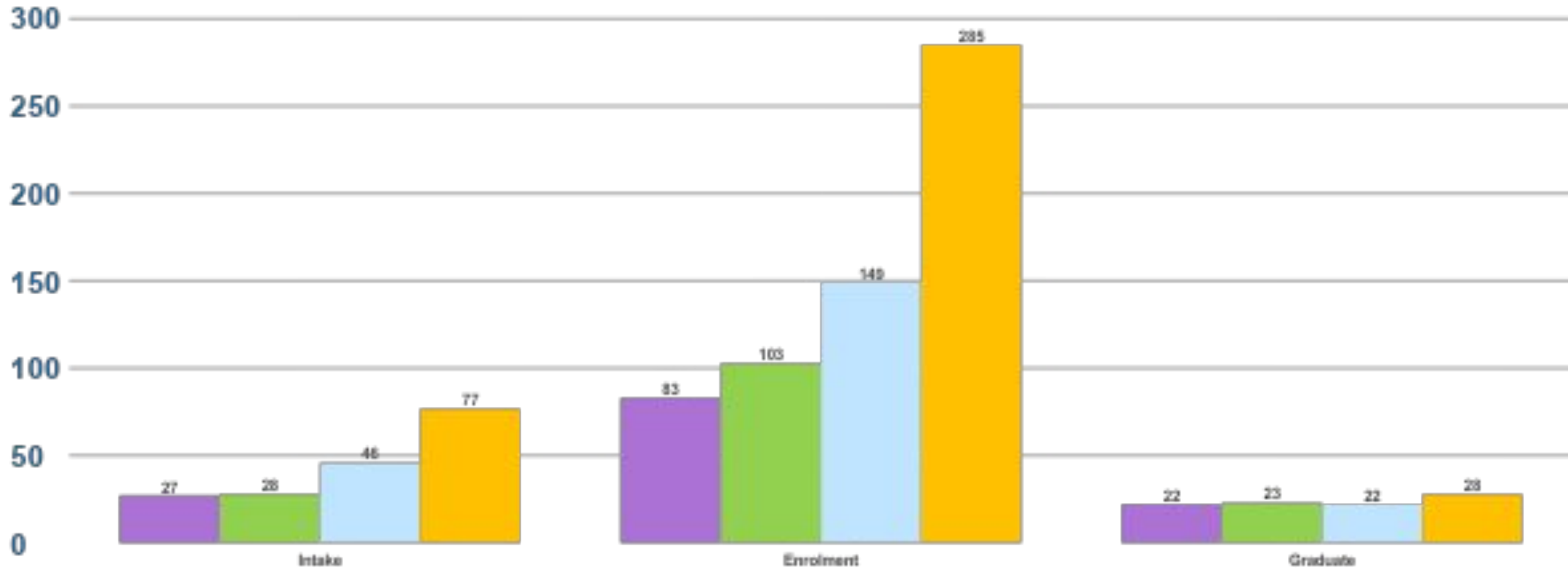

He has more than ten years lecturing and teaching experiences at degree and master level and supervised postgraduate MSc and PhD in his specialized area in Financial Economics and Insurance. In addition he has vast industrial working experiences in Banking, Insurance and Multi National Corporations (MNC's). His primary area of research interest include financial risk, economics and actuarial sciences. His current research interests include financial risk, econometrics and actuarial modelling. He is a member of Malaysia Mathematics Society, Spanish Association of International Economics and Finance (AEEFI), Malaysia Finance Association (MFA) and Malaysia Insurance Institute (MII).



PROF. DR. SITI NURSHEENA BINTI MOHD ZAIN
Prof Dr Siti Nursheena is a parasitologist in the Institute of Biological Sciences, Faculty of Science and also currently serving as a director at the International Relations Office. Her expert area is in the field of mammalian helminthology and molecular parasitology to which she obtained her PhD from Royal Holloway, University of London, UK. Her research interests covers host-parasite interactions and epidemiology of a wide range of zoonotic parasites from protozoans, helminth and ectoparasites especially from stray animals, rodents and more recently human. Presently, she is the team leader for an epidemiological investigation into the incidence of parasitic infections among vulnerable community particularly among migrant workers, refugees and the urban poor. Dr Sheena also actively contributes to the Malaysian Society of Parasitology and Tropical Medicine, and was the vice president in 2016-2018 and president in 2018-2020. She contributes her time also on 2 editorial boards; the Tropical Biomedicine (Q3) and Parasitology (Q1) editorial board.

Dr. Malarvizhi Sinayah joined academic life as a senior lecturer in Faculty of Languages and Linguistics at the University of Malaya since 2016. She is the Programme Co-ordinator of Tamil Programme at Department of Malaysian Languages and Applied Linguistics since 2017. She completed her Doctoral programme in Discourse Analysis, at Universiti Putra Malaysia; her Masters of Modern Languages Studies and her Bachelor in Languages and Linguistics (Tamil Language) at the University of Malaya, and obtained her teaching certificate (Primary School Education/Tamil Language) from Raja Melewar Teachers Training College. Her main research interests are Sociolinguistics and Discourse analysis in general, Tamil linguistics and Teaching Tamil Language and Literature in particular. Areas of particular interest include: Computer mediated Communication, language use in social Media, Codeswitching and Translanguaging, Teaching Language and Literature (Tamil), Language ideological debates relating to Minorities Language (Tamil), Intelligibility issues relating to the spread of Tamil Language, Attitudes towards minority language in higher education contexts around the world.

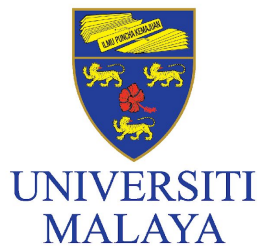
